#### **Additional Information**

- 1. Applications must include a floor plan that details proposed means of egress, seating arrangements, and the locations of all electrical or heating equipment.
- 2. The number of exits and means of egress must be determined at the time of application and clearly labeled on the floor plan.
- 3. Illuminated exit signs and emergency lighting are required for any tent with an occupant load of 50 or more, and such equipment must be operational at the time of inspection.
- 4. Hay, straw, and other combustible materials or decorations are prohibited unless approved by the Fire Inspector.
- 5. Smoking is prohibited under all tents.
- 6. Open or exposed flames shall not be permitted inside any tent, and shall not be located within 20 feet of the tent, unless approved by the Fire Inspector.
- 7. Portable fire extinguishers with current inspection tags must be on site at all times, their quantity and location to be determined by the Fire Inspector at the time of application.
- 8. Any heating, cooking, or electrical equipment authorized by the Fire Inspector must be installed according to applicable code. An electrical inspection may be required.
- 9. Fire lanes must be maintained and must remain unobstructed at all times.
- 10. A fire break or passageway not less than 12 feet wide and free of obstructions must be maintained on all sides of the tent, unless otherwise approved by the Fire Inspector.
- 11. A flame resistive certificate must be provided at the time of application, unless it is affixed to the tent.
- 12. Tents must be adequately roped, braced, and anchored to withstand the elements and prevent collapse.
- 13. A Fire Prevention Permit is required for any tent with a covered area greater than 200 square feet.
- 14. All tents covering an area less than 10,000 square feet must be separated according to the requirements of the authority having jurisdiction at the time of application or inspection.
- 15. All tents must meet the requirements of Chapter 24 of the Fire Code of NYS and NFPA 102.
- 16. Inspections must be completed *prior* to the event for which the tent is to be used, and must be completed prior to the use of any tent.
