- Construction begins July 15 on Spring Street. Parts of Spring will be closed but rear parking lots of Main Street businesses will remain open.
- Will transform road into a vibrant “B Street” of activity in the Village of Williamsville, while serving as a model of green infrastructure and stormwater management.
- “Dead areas” will become a hub of activity centered on the restored 1811 Williamsville Water Mill and a “Village Square” pedestrian plaza with a farmer’s market and events.
- Summer/Fall 2015 work: Mill Plaza (start and complete), concrete, curbs, lighting and benches installed on E. Spring Street from Main Street to Rock Street (start and complete).
- Spring Street will be turned into a one-way street during construction and Spring Street from Main to Rock will remain one-way permanently.
- Remaining work (all street paving and streetscape work on Rock Street from Main Street to E. Spring Street and on E. Spring Street from Rock Street to N. Cayuga Road) will be completed in 2016.

- Village has secured an additional \$250,000 grant to build out public plaza area and create an inviting gathering/event space and a permanent home for the Williamsville Farmers Market. (Market is located in Island Park this summer due to construction).
- Village is about to complete stabilization and restoration of historic Water Mill using \$500,000 in State Historic Preservation grant funding.
- Plan has spurred economic development: Village is selling Water Mill to Sweet Jenny's, which has opened ice cream/candy store & comic book shop. Moor Pat craft beer bar and Billybar oyster bar have opened along the street.
- Funding includes:
 - NYS Dept. Environmental Conservation WQIP (Water Quality Improvement Program) - \$1,902,180 grant
 - NYS Environmental Facilities Corp. GIGP (Green Innovation Grant Program) - \$799,160 grant
 - Funds secured by State Sen. Michael H. Ranzenhofer - \$250,000
