



Village of Williamsville elections are generally held in odd years, on the 3rd Tuesday in June. Elected officials take office on July 1st. Terms of office are 4 years each. There are no term limits. The Election Officer is the Village Clerk. For information on running for office, visit the NYS Board of Elections website at www.elections.ny.gov/RunningOffice.html. Elected Village officials are: (1) Mayor; (4) Trustees; (1) Justice.

- 2019 Village Election:** Tuesday, June 18, 2019
- Hours of voting:** Noon – 9:00 p.m.
- Location of polling place:** Village Hall, 5565 Main Street, Williamsville
- Parking:** Municipal parking lot at rear of building or where legal on street
- Handicap access:** Elevator at rear entrance of Village Hall
- Offices to fill in 2019:** One (1) Mayor for a term of four (4) years
Two (2) Trustees for a term of four (4) years each
One (1) Justice for a term of four (4) years

Eligibility to Vote in a Village Election:

- Must be a village resident for at least 30 days prior to Election Day
- Must be a registered voter in Erie County. Visit <https://www.elections.erie.gov>
- Last day individuals may register with the Erie County Board of Elections to be eligible to vote in the 2019 village election is June 7, 2019. [*Election Law §15-118(2)*]

Last day for Village Clerk to MAIL absentee ballots to qualified voters is June 12, 2019. Last day for Village Clerk to receive PERSONAL applications for an absentee ballot from applicant or applicant's agent is June 17, 2019.
