This communitywide initiative encourages YOU to place painted rocks within village gardens!
The rocks can include **INSPIRING MESSAGES, FUN ARTWORK, & VIBRANT COLORS!**

This is a way for children as well as adults to express themselves and show pride in Williamsville and it's beautiful municipal gardens!

Rock on Williamsville Guidelines:

-  Each person uses their own rocks to paint and place in the municipal gardens; rocks are not provided.
-  Painted rocks can be any size that can be easily carried by hand – such as pebbles, stones or small rocks.
-  Rocks placed in the gardens may not have explicit or illicit messages or artwork.
-  Rocks **MAY ONLY** be placed in the municipal gardens listed below. Rocks **MUST NOT** be in any other locations – this especially includes areas of open grass or spots near trees.

Drop Your Painted Rocks In These Municipal Gardens:

-  **Heritage Garden of 1812** (located at Main and Evans streets; place rocks on either side of pathway)
-  **The Village Pocket Park** (located next to Village Hall, 5565 Main St.; place rocks anywhere in garden)
-  **Garrison Park** (place rocks only at the garden that surrounds gazebo)
-  **Glen Park** (place rocks only along the pathway near the Main Street entrance)
-  **Williamsville Meeting House** (located at 5658 Main St.; place rocks in garden at front of building)
